The Council RESOLVED to object to Planning application PA/2021/645 (Changes to Condition 5) on the grounds that this change would be tantamount to granting planning approval to raising the ground level by an unacceptable level and with no specifics as to how that would be achieved. The Council RESOLVED that Cllr Adams should draft the objection.

2211Ext/05 Village Hall refurbishment

The chair reported that he had received a request through the clerk's email address for funding for new seating for the Village Hall which undergoing extensive refurbishment. A donation of £1500.00 has been requested. The Council RESOLVED to purchase appropriate seating to that value and donate the same to the Village Hall but only once full agreement had been reached on the precise requirement, style & design.
