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Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on Monday 13th October 2025 at 7pm at the Luddington & Garthorpe Primary School.

2510/01 To note apologies for absence and resignations.

Apologies received from Cllr S Walker & Ward Cllrs J Reed.

Co-option application from Mrs Huber accepted & **APPROVED**.

2510/02 Public Participation.

The Chair suspended the meeting for 15 minutes. Mr Clark requested the council to contact Yorkshire Water regarding the works & road closure on Luddington/Eastoft Road as many residents are not happy and the lack of progress made to date. Mr Carver requested an update on the footpaths; the council confirmed the modification order received last month on the agenda for this meeting. He also asked if any funds were available for repairs to the footpaths and could the trees along Eastoft Road be cut whilst the road is closed. The Chair thanked them for their contributions.

2510/04 Minutes of previous meeting.

The council **RESOLVED** to approve the minutes of the Parish Council meeting held on 8th September 2025 as a correct record & they were signed by the Chair.

2510/05 Chair's Report.

2510/06 Clerk's Accounts/Report.

The clerk confirmed the bank account balance on 13th October 2025 was £9,669.54, as per the agenda. Receipts from NLC for the grass cutting 2nd payment & £2k grant from SSE Thermal Energy. 11 invoices paid since the 8th September. These included the external audit and fence repair. This was supported by a copy of the bank statement on 30th September 2025 & reconciliation. The microgrant balance for 2025/26 is £1,150. The AGAR was finalised this month with no comments and the notice of conclusion of audit was posted on the website. The clerk will be on holiday from 8th to 17th November. The council **RESOLVED** to accept the clerk's reports.
